ORGANIZATION OVERVIEW & STATISTICS

Mission: To relieve dental pain and suffering while preserving oral health through preventive education and comprehensive treatment for those with no other access to dental care.

Year to Date Value Services Donated by the Donated Dental Program: \$ 577,927

Patient Numbers - Donated Dental Program

Total Number of Patient Visits: 402 **YTD: 1,269**

- An average of 9 patients were treated a day at SLDDS during the 3rd Quarter.
- SLDDS' volunteer dentists donated an average of **\$4,411 in services each day**.
- Average cost to SLDDS per patient visit: \$140.99

Volunteer Hours – Donated Dental Program

Throughout the 3rd Quarter a dentist volunteered services at SLDDS **148%** of the clinic's operating hours.

*There were 463 hours volunteered by dentists during the 3rd Quarter.

Total volunteer hours: 607 hours **YTD: 1,853 hours**

Procedure Breakdown – BOTH Programs

Total Procedures: 4,508 **YTD: 13,810**

- **Preventive & Restorative Procedures: 74%**
- **Prosthetic Procedures: 11%**
- **Extraction Procedures: 15%**
- Each patient received an average of \$509 in free services at each visit with SLDDS' Donated Program.
- **Procedure Overview.** Patients received: 28 crowns, 10 bridges, 25 root canals, 339 fillings, 27 denture or partial plates, 343 periodontal cleanings, 91 adult cleanings, 32 pediatric cleanings, 175 oral hygiene instruction, 25 sealants, 7 silver diamine fluoride treatment & 226 fluoride varnishes throughout the 3rd Quarter.
