ORGANIZATION OVERVIEW & STATISTICS

Mission: To relieve dental pain and suffering while preserving oral health through preventive education and comprehensive treatment for those with no other access to dental care.

Year to Date Services Provided to the Community Organization Wide: \$ 518,524

Patient Numbers - Donated Dental Program

Total Number of Patient Visits: 390 **YTD: 846**

- An average of 10 Donated patients were treated a day at SLDDS during the 2nd Quarter.
- SLDDS's volunteer dentists donated an average of **\$3,582** in services each day.

Patient Numbers - Organization Wide

Total Number of Patient Visits: 957 **YTD: 2,091**

- An average of 23 patients were treated a day at SLDDS during the 2nd Quarter.
- Average cost to SLDDS per patient visit: \$138.43

Volunteer Hours – Donated Dental Program

Throughout the 2nd Quarter a dentist volunteered services at SLDDS **126%** of the clinic's operating hours. There were 388 hours volunteered by dentists, 45 hours by hygienists, and 30 hours by dental assistants and general volunteers.

Total volunteer hours: 539 hours

Procedure Breakdown – BOTH Programs

Total Procedures: 4,348 **YTD: 8,408**

- **Preventative & Restorative Procedures: 77%**
- **Prosthetic Procedures: 9%**
- **Oral Surgery Procedures: 14%**
- Each patient received an average of \$388 in free services at each visit.
- Procedure Overview. Patients received: 31 crowns, 7 bridges, 18 root canals, 496 fillings, 25 denture or partial plates, 331 periodontal cleanings, 80 adult cleanings, 45 pediatric cleanings, 120 oral hygiene instruction, 41 sealants, 14 silver diamine fluoride app, & 128 fluoride varnishes throughout the 2nd Quarter.
